GUARANTEED ADMISSION OPTION

Students who enroll in pre-nursing courses at Emporia State University (ESU) are eligible for the Guaranteed Admission Option to the nursing program. Successful completion of all the following requirements must occur to be admitted through the Guaranteed Admission Option.

Requirements

1. Apply and be accepted to ESU as a pre-nursing major student.
2. Review current ESU Nursing Admission Policies for Generic Students carefully and contact the ESU Nursing office regarding questions about admission requirements or the Guaranteed Admission Option.
3. Complete the *Letter of Request* form for the Guaranteed Admission Option and submit it to ESU Nursing. Confirmation of receipt will be mailed to the student.
4. Complete all the “Admission Requirements” listed in the *ESU Nursing Admission Policies for Generic Students*. Watch deadlines carefully.
5. Follow the “Application Procedure” as instructed in the *ESU Nursing Admission Policies for Generic Students* and submit all application materials by February 1 for fall admission priority deadline, and September 1 for spring admission priority deadline.
6. By June 1 and/or January 1 of the admission year:
 - a. Complete the 60 required non-nursing credit hours from the list of non-nursing courses located in the “Curriculum” section of the *ESU Nursing Admission Policies for Generic Students*. **A minimum of 48 of the 60 required non-nursing credit hours must be completed at ESU. A maximum of 12 credit hours of the required 60 non-nursing credit hours may be transferred to ESU.**
 - b. Achieve at least a 3.0 GPA for all courses taken at ESU (Institutional GPA).
 - c. Achieve a “C” or higher in non-nursing course work regardless of overall cumulative GPA.
7. Maintain a minimum 3.0 admission grade point average (Admission GPA).
8. Maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average (Overall GPA).

REQUIRED NON-NURSING COURSES • SAMPLE CURRICULUM GUIDE

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree requires a total of 120 credit hours (60 nursing credits and 60 non-nursing credits). All non-nursing required courses are pre-requisite courses to be completed prior to entering the nursing program. **Students applying to the nursing program for Fall 2026 must have completed 8 hours of Anatomy and Physiology courses including labs. Students seeking admission prior to fall 2026 must have completed at least 5 hours of Anatomy and Physiology courses including lab.**
