AY 2022-2023 Summary:

The Kansas State Department of Education requires a program pass-rate of 80% or higher on the Praxis II and PLT exams. An overall pass-rate of 92.18% was observed for secondary/K-12 initial program completers who took a required exam, 90.08% was observed for elementary initial program completers who took a required exam, and 95.28% of completers who took a Principles of Learning and Teaching exam, each of which exceeds the minimum threshold set by the Kansas State Department of Education.
